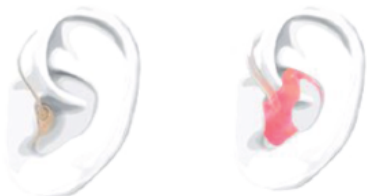

How to care for your aid

Maintenance

- Change your tubing **every 6 months**



Cleaning

- Wipe over your ear mould (the piece that goes in the ear) with a wet wipe every day to keep it clean

Used Batteries

Used batteries can be returned to us or disposed of at the collection bins at many supermarkets
